FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why is there an option to pledge \$18.67 per week? Isn't that a strange number?

Yes, it is a strange number. 1867 is also the year we celebrate as the birth of St. Mark's Episcopal Church, so it makes sense in a way. Last year, we added this strange number to the pledge card as a way to invite those who pledge less than \$1,000 a year (and who have the means possibly to pledge more) to make our parish's birth year your weekly commitment. We decided to do so again. We know not everyone can make such a financial commitment, so please do not feel pressure to do so. But if you can, please consider the birth year pledge!

What is the purpose of the "Together in Love" pledge drive? God calls us to be good stewards of God's blessings year round, and we focus on monetary giving this time of year in order to invite our members to contribute their financial resources back to God's mission at St. Mark's, as well as to help deepen their commitment to God in Christ. In this year of unprecedented crisis, we are celebrating that God continues to bring us together in love any way we can.

How do I determine the amount of my pledge? Financial commitment to God's mission at St. Mark's is a personal, intentional, and spiritual decision that we hope you make after much thought, prayer, and in consultation with a spouse or trusted friend. The average pledge in 2020 was \$3,076. One way to determine your pledge is through incremental increase; that is, increase your pledge by a percentage over last year. For example, if you pledged \$5,000 for 2020, you might increase by 10% to pledge \$5,500 for 2021. Another method is proportional giving.

What is proportional giving? The biblical tithe is the standard of giving in the Old Testament scriptures: 10% of income, given as the first fruits of love and trust to God's mission. In biblical times, this giving went to the temple's storehouse to help widows and orphans. The 10% tithe is the basis of the idea of proportional giving, though you may decide to give a different proportion. Here is a chart with some examples.

Sample Proportional Giving Percentages			
Income	5%	7%	10%
\$20,000	\$1,000	\$1,400	\$2,000
\$50,000	\$2,500	\$3,500	\$5,000
\$100,000	\$5,000	\$7,000	\$10,000
\$250,000	\$12,500	\$17,500	\$25,000

Are there ways besides cash and checks by which to fulfill my pledge? Yes. Some may prefer to give from their capital assets. Appreciated securities, for example, may offer a tax advantage not available in a cash gift.

Doesn't the church receive assistance from the diocese? No. Our entire operating budget comes from the collective pledges of our parishioners, plus a few fundraisers throughout the year.

Why is a pledge preferred to a one-time donation? For most, spreading a pledge out over twelve months (or 52 weeks) allows for a more substantial gift than a single donation and turns the act of giving into a frequent spiritual discipline. Making a pledge also helps us plan next year's budget and helps with monthly cash flow.

What about planned giving in my will? In addition to current yearly giving, notifying the church that one's will includes a bequest facilitates long-term financial planning. Check the box on the front side of this sheet for more information about planned giving to the St. Mark's Endowment.

Should I use the "donate online" button on the church's website to pay my pledge? It is possible to do so, but we would prefer you pay another way, since the platform we use to receive online donations takes a small cut, which eats into each donation. The "donate online" button is designed for non-pledgers who feel moved to make small one-time donations to the church for various reasons.
